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Part 1

Welcome to the second portion of the Communication Skills for Researchers section of the Freshman Course. In this portion we will introduce basic skills for creating scientific presentations and poster presentations to efficiently communicate your research findings.

How to proceed:

The presentation portion is divided into **5 parts**. For each part you can access the lecture slides and text, video portion if there is a video for that part, the Google form link for the practice exercises, and the mandatory homework assignment for the last part (Part 5). Hold down the Control (ctrl) key on your keyboard and click on the link if you are studying from a computer.

You will receive the Word file with the corresponding download links for the next part of the lecture only after you have successfully completed and submitted your responses in the Google form practice exercise. In the practice exercises and homework, you are expected to type your original ideas in sentence and essay form. These answers should demonstrate that you have genuinely thought about and understood the ideas presented in the lecture. All practice exercises and homework are mandatory.
